In addition to directing the Apprentice Company productions & the Young Playwrights Festival showcase at Horizon Theatre, she has served as the dramaturge for *Jim Crowe* and *the Rhythm Darlings* with Essential Theatre; as the Senior Director in the Professional Training Program Shakespeare Theatre of New Jersey (STNJ); Assistant Director for STNJ, Cincinnati Playhouse in the Park, and Theatre in the Square; the Artistic/Executive Director of the Waco Civic Theatre; an Instructor at the University of Memphis; Project Manager for the Chicago Symphony Orchestra; and Chapter Coordinator & Rehearsal Associate for Lyric Opera of Chicago. She has produced over 40 productions and directed over 30 productions, including critically acclaimed productions of *The Clearing*, *Macbeth*, & *The Serpent* (UM), *Aesop's Fables* for Opera Memphis, *The Winter's Tale* & *The Herbal Bed* (LateNite at STNJ), and *Into The Woods*, *Dancing at Lughnasa*, & *Jesus Christ, Superstar* at WCT. She serves as Co-President of the Atlanta Coalition for Performing Arts Board of Directors and an Atlanta Suzi Judge. Jennifer holds a BA in Vocal Music performance, Theatre, and English from Ripon College and is a member of the Stage Directors and Choreographers Society, the professional national labor union.
