Getting To The Theatre On Thursday, October 24, 2019



Horizon Theatre is located at 1083 Austin Ave, Atlanta, Georgia 30307, the corner of Austin and Euclid Avenues.

It is an old school building.

Enter the parking lot and drive up the slope to the back of the building for parking.

There is the Inman Park/ Reynoldstown MARTA station nearby, too.

When You Arrive at Horizon Theatre On Thursday, October 24, 2019

You will enter from the parking lot through the tan door with the "Entrance Sign" hanging above it.


You will walk down the short corridor

The lobby and stairs may be full of other people coming to see the show. They will be friendly and may want to chat.

It's okay to talk to them or not to. Being silent is okay.




If You Need a Quiet Space.....

As you come to the stairs, look to your right.

This is the Blue Room.

At any time during the evening that you need a quiet space, this room is here for you to visit.




Restrooms

Across from the Blue Room are the restrooms.

If you need to go to the restroom during the show, that's okay. Remember to exit the theatre quietly and go back down the steps to the restroom.

When you come back to the theatre, an usher will help you get back to your seat



Getting Your Tickets!

At the top of the steps, is our **Box Office.**

There may be a line when you arrive. This is okay.

When you get to the front of the line, give the Box Office person your name. You will be given your ticket.

If you'd like to request ear plugs or fidget items for during the show, ask the person next to the box office for whatever you need.





Continue through the next set of green doors.

Concession Area




Before you enter the actual theatre auditorium there is a

"Concession" area where snacks and drinks may be purchased.

If you buy something you may take it into the theatre with you.

If you don't wish to buy anything, that is okay.



Continue through the next set of open doors. These lead into the theatre itself. An usher will help you find a seat.

Before the Show Starts



When you're seated but before the show starts, Lisa Adler, Co-Artistic Producer of Horizon Theatre will come out and speak to the audience, including you.

She will talk about Horizon Theatre and about the show you are about to see. She will tell you things to watch out for, what will happen in the show and things like that.

When she is done, the lighting will change. The room will be darker and the play will start.

During The Show

As the show starts, the lights will lower so the theatre is dark.

Lights will come up on stage and actors will say their lines.





Throughout the show there may be loud sounds or changes in lights that happen rapidly. You will be warned when they are about to happen so you can close your eyes or put on your headphones.

After The Show

When the show ends, people will clap. You can join in if you'd like or not as you choose.



Audience members—including you—can go down on the stage and meet the cast members.

It may be crowded.

OR You can just exit the theatre as you came in.
